Username

Your HindsNet username will be the first initial of your last name, followed by your full Hinds ID number.

Password

Your initial password is your first and last initials (capitalized) + full date of birth (ex: 01011970) + the \$ sign.

For Example:

John Smith (Hinds ID number 1234567), who was born on Jan 1, 1970, would use the following login information:

Username: S1234567 *Password:* JS0101970\$

Once logged in to your Canvas site, go to Courses on the left side of the screen to access your courses.
